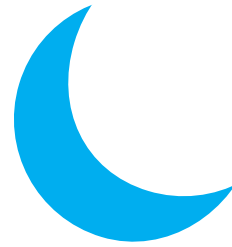




Train Travel Times

Satisfying the Need for Speed in 2008

The new high-speed TGV Est line in France has cut travel times in half from Paris to Eastern France and neighboring countries (Luxembourg, Germany and Switzerland). Paris is now just 2h 20min from Strasbourg and 1h 30min from Nancy, or just 45min from the Champagne region of Reims.

And with the recent launch of Eurostar's high speed line, travel time has been reduced to just 2h 15min from central London to central Paris and just under 2h from London to Brussels.

Europe is shrinking and continues to become more accessible with the vast network of high-speed trains. Convenience, access and speed make the train the preferred choice for traveling in true European comfort and style.

Also new: the Eurail Global Pass has expanded and now provides rail travel throughout 20 countries. Plus there are more choices and country combinations including Eurail Denmark-Sweden, Eurail Finland-Sweden, Eurail Norway-Sweden and the Eurail Scandinavia Pass covering Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden.
